PHOTOGRAPHY STATEMENT

Photography (for personal / family use) at Andrews Cup Association Events

1.1. Statement of Intent

- The Andrews Cup Association is mindful of the possibility of indecent photography of students participating at sporting events.
- The Andrews Cup Association owes a duty of care to students participating in sporting events and has an obligation to comply with policies and procedures concerning child protection matters.
- The Andrews Cup Association recognises that it is a normal and appropriate expectation of parents / carers to be able to visually record the sporting achievements of their children. However, this expectation must be balanced against legitimate concerns that may be raised about inappropriate photography of students.
- The Andrews Cup Association also recognises that some venue managers/owners may not permit photography in the competition venue.

1.2. Statement of Practice

- The taking of photographs (for personal / family use) is therefore permitted at Andrews Cup events except where an event is held at a venue where venue management prohibits such photography.
- Where a venue prohibits photography signage stating that photography is not permitted will be displayed.
- Where an Andrews Cup representative reasonably considers that a spectator is engaged in photography of an indecent nature or is engaging in photography contrary to the venue owner's prohibition, if the spectator does not discontinue, they will be asked to leave the event premises. Police may be called to assist where the school host and or Andrews Cup official and or Executive Officer considers it prudent.

The management of this policy is the responsibility of the Host School and Andrews Cup Executive Officer in consultation with the Andrews Cup President and Association members.
